A vaccine is our most effective measure to combat COVID-19. The scientific evidence before us shows that vaccines work. They are safe. They are effective, and they save lives.





Those eligible must register for a vaccine whether it is online, via SMS, by phone, or in person.


Let us mobilize our structures to assist our elderly to register and receive their vaccination.
